Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be an active 4-H or FFA member of the current year
- Must be an active member in good standing of a Carroll County 4-H Club or FFA Chapter
- Must be accepted to or already attending a college or vocational school
- Must be exhibit Beef, Sheep, or Swine at the county level for the current year
- Applications must be complete
- Applications must be submitted on or before the deadline

Scholarship Requirements:

- A completed application
- Academic Transcript from the most current academic period
- Two letters of recommendations
- Letter to Selection Committee from the candidate, telling why he/she should be awarded this scholarship
- Essay: "How has 4-H helped me become the person I am today?"

This Scholarship may be awarded more than once to any candidate as long as eligibility requirements are met. The decision of the selection committee will be final. The recipient(s) will be recognized at the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Livestock sale.
