

4HOnline FAQ

Thank you for your interest in Frederick County 4-H! Our program is growing and changing and currently has over 500 4-H youth members and over 300 trained adult volunteers. We are very active in the community and offer many opportunities to learn new skills as both a youth or volunteer member.

For Clovers (ages 5-7) and Youth members (ages 8-18) to enroll in the 4HOnline system you need to:

- Choose a 4-H Unit (a 4-H club, camp or independent learning) If you are not a member of a Unit or
 Club please go to our clubs page at https://extension.umd.edu/locations/frederick-county/local-4-h-youth-education/join-4-h to see where our clubs are located. Each club has a page with meeting dates and times and also the Club Leader's contact information so you can get more information or visit a meeting to help in deciding on a club that is a good fit for your child.
- Choose a 4-H project (or projects) for the year. You will choose your project each year, they do not
 roll over year to year. If you would like to choose a project that is not listed please select SelfDetermined.

ALL 4-H Volunteers MUST enroll in 4-HOnline each year and be approved by March 10 in order to volunteer with 4-H Youth.

Here are some helpful hints when using 4-HOnline:

- 4-H Online works best with the following internet browsers: **Google Chrome, Firefox and Safari**.
- The program is NOT compatible with Internet Explorer or Edge.
- 4-H Online is mobile-device friendly.
- If you are unable to access compatible browsers, or having any issues with enrolling in 4-HOnline, please contact the 4-H office at the contact information below and we are happy to set a time for you to come in so we may assist you.
- If there is a problem with your enrollment we will send it back with a comment explaining what needs to be changed or updated so we are able to approve the enrollment.
- The \$10.00 4-H State Membership Dues will post to your bank or credit card account once we approve your youth enrollment.
- A member MUST be enrolled by May 1st in order to be eligible to show through 4-H at Maryland State Fair and/or The Great Frederick Fair.
