



Maryland 4-H State Council

State Council is a statewide leadership organization open to all 4-H members ages 13 - 18 as of January 1 of the current year. Comprised of youth officers, general members and 4-H faculty/staff advisors, the State Council is designed to offer youth a premiere leadership opportunity. Members represent their local 4-H program, network and learn with peers from across the state, and support/ promote 4-H and 4-H events.



General membership applications are accepted from September 15th - November 15th each year and applicants are notified by December 15th. The State Council program year begins January 1st and is launched with a retreat to prepare members for their roles and create their plan of work.

Activities

State Council members work together to create, promote, and teach educational activities aligned with 4-H projects. These activities are used in virtual connections, in person programs, and at statewide events.
