<u>4-H Youth Membership Requirements</u>

To become a member of 4-H, youth need to be 8 to 18 years old as of January I. For 4-H Clovers, the age requirement is 5 to 7 years old as of January I. To be a member in good standing, you must attend a percentage of club meetings established in your club by-laws to be eligible to participate in events, such as but not limited to, fairs (county and state), showing animal projects, participating in county and state contests.
