CRITERIA

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. Be a 4-H member in Carroll County
- 2. Be a graduating senior of high school graduate
- 3. Be accepted at or already attending college or post secondary school.
- 4. Must have exhibited sheep at the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair for at least one year.
- Must comply with current record keeping requirements for the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Livestock Sale.

Selection will be based on:

- 1. 4-H accomplishments, participation, financial need, and high school grades
- 2. Applicant must furnish a transcript of high school grades.
- 3. Applicant must furnish two letters of recommendation.
- 4. Applicant must submit a senior record book/portfolio along with the application to be considered for this scholarship. The senior portfolio/record book may represent records submitted any year since their 4-H age became 14.
- 5. Decision of the Selection Committee will be final.
- 6. Applicants may be interviewed.
- 7. The Selection Committee may decide not to award a scholarship if there are no worthy applicants.

This scholarship may only be awarded once to each individual.

Recipient will be recognized at the 4-H Livestock Sale at the Carroll County 4-H/FFA Fair.

Completed applications, grade transcripts, and record book/portfolios are due to the Carroll County 4-H Office by June 30. Applicants will be notified of the interview schedule.
